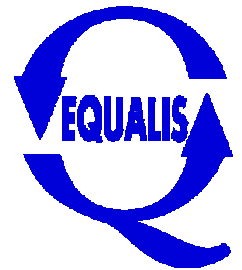
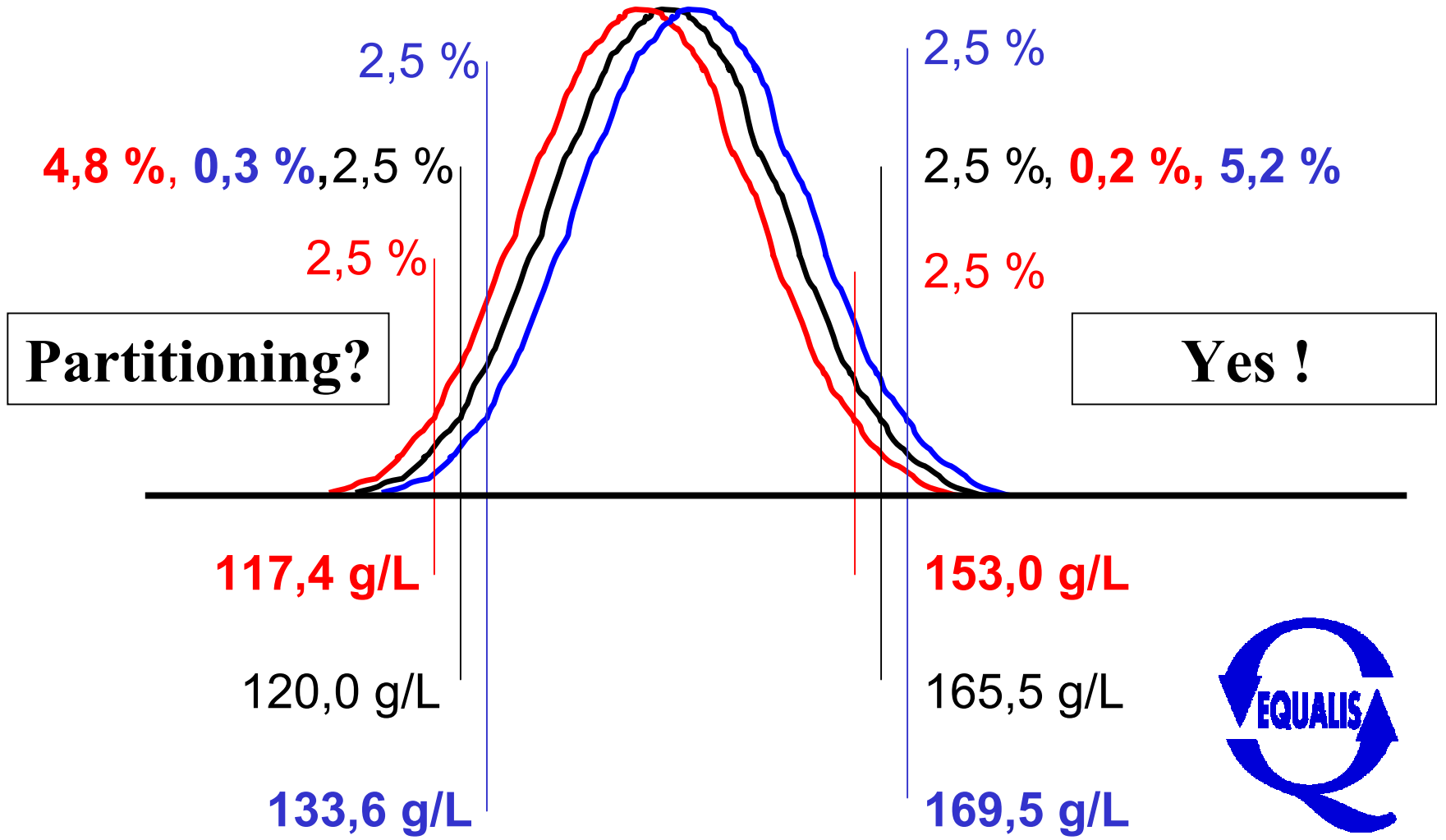
B-Hb dependence on country and sex



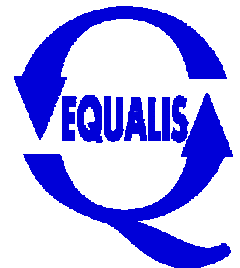
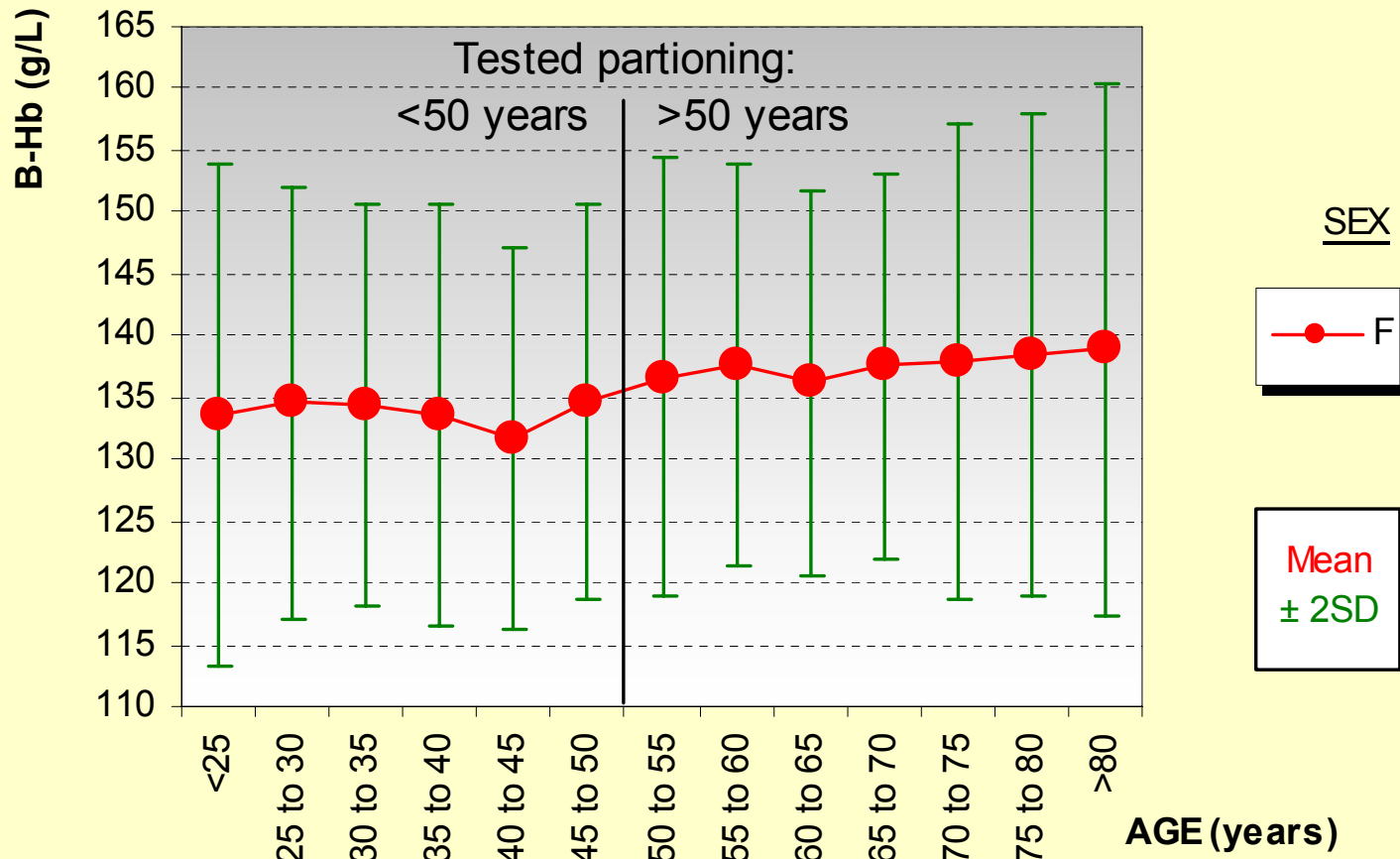
